Learning Objective:

- to memorize the poetry and to pronounce correctly the words that make up the verses of the poem;
- to become familiar with new words in poetry;
- to make the flags of the European countries using the acquired skills;
- to associate each flag with the country it represents.

Resources:

- Methods and procedures: conversation, explanation, demonstration, exercise, problematization, exhibition
- •Teaching aids: colored paper, glue, map of Europe
- Forms of organization: in groups, in teams, individually, frontally

Lesson Outline:

Lesson Introduction: Surprise presentation of the map of Europe. The theme of the activity is announced.

Main Lesson: The poem is recited by the educator, then repeated with each child. Children receive a flag from one of the Erasmus partner countries. Then they go to the tables where they have prepared materials to make each one a flag. After finishing, each child places the flag in the right country.

Plenary: The children were interested in learning the poem "My European Family" and were happy to make flags and associate them with the countries they represent.
